The research focus of the chair should strengthen the scientific focus on metabolism and metabolic diseases (e.g. in the areas of neuronal control of metabolism, organ crosstalk or mechanisms of vascular complications and organ damage of metabolic diseases) of the Institute of Physiology and the Faculty of Medicine. We look forward to your willingness to integrate your research program into the innovative research environment of the biomedical campus, the Faculty of Medicine and the Carl Gustav Carus University Hospital and offer you extensive networking opportunities with the health research centers at the faculty (DZD, DZNE and DKFZ). We also appreciate your special commitment in the organization and implementation of curricular teaching, especially in the medicine and dentistry study programs, the MEDiC study program, and the bachelor's study program in midwifery. We also expect your active involvement in academic self-administration.

We are looking for an integrative personality with internationally recognized scientific achievements and appropriate third-party funding. Appointment requirements include a completed university degree, a doctorate and habilitation or equivalent achievements in a subject relevant to the content of this chair as well as proof of an extensive teaching experience over several years. Given the vast majority of teaching activities are conducted in German, the position requires excellent German speaking and writing skills. Recognition as a *Facharzt/Fachärztin für Physiologie* or *Fachphysiologe/Fachphysiologin* is desirable, but not a requirement. Applicants must fulfill the employment qualification requirements of § 58 of the Act on the Autonomy of Institutions of Higher Education in the Free State of Saxony (SächsHSFG).
